Policy Statement

Finger Lakes Community College shall inform incoming students about sexual assault prevention measures through programs such as multi-media presentations in order to promote discussion of and to disseminate information about sexual assault, encourage reporting of incidents of sexual assault, and facilitate prevention of such incidents. Specifically, the College shall provide education to promote the awareness of stalking, rape, and other sex offenses. These education and information programs should include, but not be limited to, the following subjects:

- The applicable state laws, ordinances, and regulations regarding sex offenses;
- The penalties under state law for commission of sex offenses as well as on-campus disciplinary sanctions for the same;
- The procedures in effect at the College for dealing with sex offenses;
- The availability of counseling and other support services for the victims of sex offenses on campus and off campus;
- The nature of and common circumstances relating to sex offenses on college campuses;
- The methods the campus employs to advise and to update students about security procedures.

Finger Lakes Community College is required to file an annual report on its compliance with NYS Education Law § 6432 with the New York State Commissioner of Education.
